

COVID UPDATE
February 19, 2021

The Governor of Nevada has issued directive 037, “Nevada’s Roadmap to Recovery”. This new directive is effective February 18, 2021. The directive allows for an increase in occupancy and easing of restrictions statewide. The following are a few items remaining in compliance and changes for Sun City Mesquite.

- Masks or face coverings will continue to be required, except while participating in outdoor activities such as Pickleball, Tennis, Bocce Ball or Putting. Masks or face coverings will still be required to and from the courts along with strict Social Distancing.
- Occupancy of areas of use have been increased from 25% to 35%. This change will be reflected by an additional number of reservations allowed.
- Showers and Lockers remain closed at this time but will be re-evaluated in March.
- Personal Trainers will be allowed at the Pioneer Center and not count against occupancy limits.
- Reservation system will remain in effect due to the need for contact tracing.
- Outdoor Pool area to re-open Thursday, April 15, 2021 and will be open until 8 p.m. seven days a week. Occupancy limits will be reviewed March 11 for any updates.

Community staff and the Board of Directors will be meeting again March 11, 2021 to review any new guidelines or directives. Directive 037 provides further ease of restrictions that become effective on March 15. The Board and staff will be poised to implement those changes when effective. The Board is trying to balance a return to a normal type of lifestyle while adhering to the governor’s directives for the safety of all our residents.
